Immunization is a way of creating immunity to certain diseases. Adults also need to be protected against diseases. If you have not been vaccinated, or if it is time for re-vaccination (Tetanus, Flu), several immunizations are available at the Health Department including the Shingles vaccine (for adults age 60 or older). Fees are subject to manufacture cost. Consult your physician or the Health Department about recommended and/or required vaccines.

They are facilitating trails by ElectroCell which has technology to consolidate phosphorous in a swine manure pit; they are assisting Greenleaf Advisors in setting up Gypsum test plots on farms in the watershed; and they will be hosting a meeting with representatives from the Ohio State University Ag department and local producers. This meeting is being held to discuss the outcome of a \$50,000.00 solution seeking grant.
