The December 2, Ag Solutions Meeting held at the Library was successful. Glen Arnold from Putnam County gave an informative presentation on side dressing standing corn with manure on local test plats. Glen's scientific tracking of these test plots reflect that this is an effective way to apply manure in the early summer and the nutrient uptake by the plants is very efficient using this approach. Crop yields match or surpass commercial fertilizer.

There was no formal Ag Ed Boosters Meeting in November. The Boosters attended a Greenhand and Chapter Degree Ceremony. These degrees are the entry level degrees in the FFA program. Booster member Terry Mescher addressed the group assuring them that the boosters will continue to support the program in any way they can.
