Cool Tips for Cold Temperatures

- If you plan to be outside for a while, let someone know.
- Excess perspiration will increase heat loss. Remove extra layers of clothing whenever you feel too warm.
- Walk carefully on snowy, icy sidewalks.
- Don't use cold weather as an excuse not to exercise-but dress appropriately and wear sunscreen (or move your workout inside).
- When shoveling snow, take frequent breaks and stay hydrated. Avoid overexertion.

What Should I do if I get Stranded in Cold Weather?

- Tie a brightly colored cloth to the antenna as a signal to rescuers.
- Move anything you need from the trunk into the passenger area.
- Wrap your entire body, including your head, in extra clothing, blankets, or newspapers.
- Stay awake. You will be less vulnerable to cold-related health problems.
- Run the motor and heater for about 10 minutes per hour. Make sure that snow is not blocking the exhaust pipe.
- As you sit, keep moving your arms and legs to improve your circulation and stay warmer.
- Do not eat snow because it will lower your body temperature.

With planning and a bit of caution, you'll make it to the spring thaw, safe and sound!
