February is American Heart Month

Heart disease is the leading cause of death for men and women in the United States. Every year, 1 in 4 deaths are caused by heart disease.

The good news? Heart disease can often be prevented when people make healthy choices and manage their conditions. Communities, health professionals, and families can work together to create opportunities for people to make healthier choices.

You can make healthy changes to lower your risk of developing heart disease. Controlling and preventing risk factors is also important for people. To lower your risk:

- Watch your weight.
- Quit smoking and stay away from secondhand smoke.
- Control your cholesterol. You should get your cholesterol checked at least every 5 years. If you have been diagnosed with high cholesterol, you may need your cholesterol checked more frequently.
- Monitor your blood pressure. High blood pressure may have no symptoms, so be sure to have it checked on a regular basis.
- If you drink, drink in moderation.
- Get active.
- Eat healthy. Include several servings of fruit and vegetables in your diet every day.
- Manage diabetes. If you have diabetes, check your blood sugar levels carefully and write them down for a better reference for your health care provider.

If you take medication to treat high cholesterol, high blood pressure, or diabetes, follow your doctor's instructions carefully. Always ask questions if you don't understand.

The 716 Sidewalk Project is still progressing. The preferred location for the sidewalk is on the ODOT right of way between the road and the power poles. This area is already crowded with various infrastructure such as sewer line inspection points, cable boxes, storm drains and poles that may be too close to the highway and would have to be moved. The good news is that ODOT will not require expensive, certified prints. The not so good news is that to meet current ODOT specs, the sidewalk will need to be 5 feet wide which will add expense.
