12 Holiday Health & Safety Tips

- 1. Shovel Safely: Take frequent breaks. Warm up before shoveling with light shoveling.
- 2. Bundle Up: Wear a hat. 40% of body heat is lost from your head.
- 3. Light your Tree, but not on Fire: Pick a flame retardant tree if artificial.
