MULTI-USE PATH

There have not been any new updates on the Marion Community Greenway Project. With many generous donations already pledged, local funds committed have reached over \$215,000. The timeline for the project is projected to be 2020 Land Acquisition Phase and 2021 Construction Phase. This project would not be possible without the generosity and support of many organizations, businesses and people, all which help make this community incredible! The committee has also recently applied for an Ohio Capital Grant which will help offset the remaining funds needed. The timeframe for notification of the grant application approval is Spring 2020.
