The Ag Department would like to welcome Greg Bruns as the new Co-Ag Teacher for the 2023-2024 School Year since Sophie Hoelscher took a new position at New Bremen. He will be teaching the Woodworking, Agriculture, Food & Natural Resources (AFNR), Drafting, and CBI classes. The Boosters are planning to purchase new equipment for the school year.

Mark Hardesty provided an update on the Ag Solutions front as well. The treatment trains are up and running well. They are processing the maximum amount of water we can at each site. The Mercer Wildlife Area Phase 2 project should be starting very soon, and the Chickasaw Creek wetland project construction contract will be awarded by the end of this month. They have received three new Clean Ohio grants to purchase about 30 acres in total at three different locations. The future plans

for all three sites are wetlands for water treatment and native grasses and forbs. Theresa Dirksen is also working on two potential new applications. More to come on all these projects.
